## Some wonderful things happened in 2014:



First, the home/orphanage got a well with a water pump powered by solar power. This helps the children in cooking, washing, laundry, and gardening, and it serves the neighbors.

Second, a new school was built and is running with 150 students in 6 classrooms, grades 1-4 and 7-8. With funds from Christian Broadcasting Network, a second school building is being constructed.
