Some wonderful new things happened in 2014. First, **the orphanage has a well!** Christian Broadcasting Network (CBN) dug a well 110 meters deep, with a solar-powered pump. The children now have water every day of the year – for cooking, washing, laundry, and gardening. Already they are growing an acre of tomatoes using drip irrigation.



Neighbors are also welcome to use the well.

Second, a German donor made it possible to build **a one story school**, and already it is in use (pictured unfinished below). CBN plans to build a second floor.



With your generosity we continue to provide \$1250 per month for food, and \$2000 for school fees every trimester.



Georgette's dream, and ours, is that the orphanage will provide for some of its own needs. The well, the garden, and tuition fees from the school are now making that dream real.
