Thank you for your support during the last 12 years. Here's the latest news from the children you have been supporting.



For 12 years you have partnered with us to support 54 children in Kinshasa Congo in their education and maturation. Students who were in Grade 1 when we started are now entering their graduation year!



Education: Almost 20 students have already graduated high school, and this year eight of them are hoping to attend

University - six for their first year, and one girl (Tshanda) for her third year. Each needs \$1,000 Cdn for tuition and books for the year.

To cover their other school costs they are working at kiosks like this, and making cement bricks for sale in the neighbourhood. They'd love

to have you help them with their tuition – by cheque or on-line.

The eighth student Guillan, seen on the right, is in his final year of medical school, and his fees are almost completely covered by generous donors. Thank you!



Nutrition: Food prices keep rising. The orphans are now eating better because we raised our monthly food



support by US\$1000 to US\$2250, which is \$800 Cdn more than we currently bring in monthly. To sustain this beyond 2018, we need to raise more funds, especially in regular monthly support.

Here we see the former cook and some of the older children preparing cassava leaves for a sauce to go with the 'fufu' that forms the basis of their diet.

Our crokinole fundraiser in April raised \$4230 for school fees. We are most grateful! Thank you! You are
